Based on the EASA high level of interest with innovation, and the use of technology in supporting aviation personnel's increased proficiency with different aircraft types and models, on the 29th January 2019, EASA CT 1 hosted a meeting with TFC Simulatoren und Technik GmbH, on “ Cabin Crew Virtual Training”.

With an experience of more than 30 years of constructing Cabin Emergency Evacuation Trainers, and of installing more than 200 cabin crew simulators for over 50 international airlines (e.g. Lufthansa; Air France; Emirates, ANA), TFC introduced their most recent development- the Virtual Reality Trainer- with applications for cabin crew door operation and in-flight fire-fighting.

Gathering a cross-Agency audience, the meeting allowed for practical use of the TFC Virtual Reality Training Tool and enabled discussions from several perspectives, such as: cabin safety; cabin crew operation; safety intelligence and performance.
